## GUEST SPEAKER- LT. KOULA ZAMBOUNIS-BLACK

Lt. Koula Zambounis-Black of the Salisbury Police Department will present a program for the community at St. Luke's on **Monday, September 18th at 6pm** in the Parish Hall. She will be addressing police training and crisis intervention. Lt. Black holds the position of organizational development lieutenant. Her primary responsibilities include the oversight of community policing initiatives, community engagement, peer support and officer development, recruitment and retention, diversity, equity and inclusion, and the school resource officer program. She has been featured in IACP's "Police Chief" Magazine for her development of the Lotus Project. This event, jointly hosted by Soliders Memorial AME Zion Church, is a follow-up to questions raised in the *Just Mercy* book study and is offered to the entire community.
